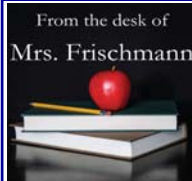
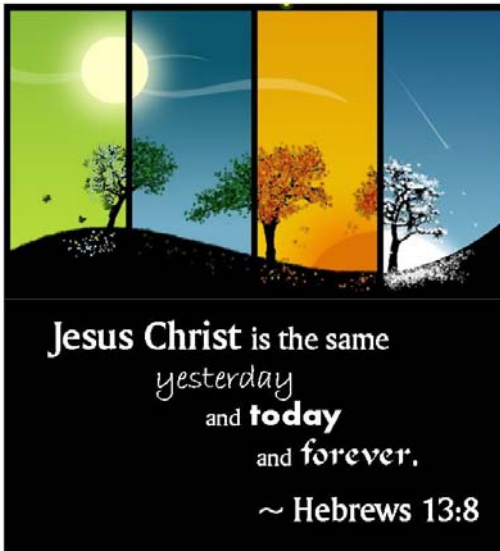


Prowling About

CHAPEL "BRING LIST"

PK2 - School Supplies - Examples: boxes of 12 colored pencils with a sharpener, watercolor paints, regular pencils, crayons, markers, small pads of plain paper or small coloring books

PK3 & 1st Gr. - School Supplies - Examples: boxes of 12 colored pencils with a sharpener, watercolor paints, regular pencils, crayons, markers, small pads of plain paper or small coloring books

PK4 & 6th Gr. - Small soft toy for boy or girl - Examples: stuffed animal, doll,

4th Gr. - small active toy for a boy or girl age 2-9. Remember, it must fit in a shoe box and may not have any "war" or "gun" theme. Suggestions: yo yos, jump ropes, small balls, slinkies, hackysacks,

3rd Gr. & 2nd Gr. - Toiletries - Examples: bars of soap, toothbrushes, combs, hairbrush, hair bands, bows, bandaids, re-usable cups or water bottles

KDG & 5th Gr. - Fun Items - Examples: small cups of playdoh, small toys like building things, dinosaurs
